EASY PONCHO & BAG

SIZES

Poncho: To fit Bust Measurement

Small/X-Large 30-40 ins [76-101.5 cm]

2X-Large/5X-Large 42-52 " [106.5-132 "]

Bag: 14 ins x 10 ins [35.5 cm x 25.5 cm]

MATERIALS: Patons Mosaic (50g/1.75 oz)

Poncho

Sizes	S-XL	2XL-5XL	
12135 (Florentine)	5	8	balls

Bag

12135 (Florentine)		3	balls
--------------------	--	---	--------------

Size 6.5 mm (U.S. K or 10½) crochet hook for Poncho and 5.5 mm (U.S. I or 9) crochet hook for Bag **or size needed to obtain tension.** Pair of 10 ins [25.5 cm] wide plastic handles for Bag.

TENSION

Poncho: 10 dc and 6 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] with larger hook.

Bag: 11 sc and 11 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] with smaller hook.

INSTRUCTIONS

Poncho

The instructions are written for smaller size. If changes are necessary for larger size the instructions will be written thus ().

Ch 43 (55).

Foundation row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook. 1 dc in each of next 3 ch. *Ch 1. Miss next ch. 1 dc in each of next 5 ch. Rep from * to end of ch. 41 (54) sts.

1st row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in next dc. *Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. Rep from * to last 3 dc. Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 dc in each of last 2 dc. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in next dc. *1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. Ch 1. Miss next dc. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures approx 40 (48) ins [101.5 (122) cm], ending on a 2nd row. Fasten off.

Finishing: Sew foundation chain to side edge as shown in Diagram.

Edging: Join yarn with sl st into corner st at neck edge.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. Work a further 59 (67) sc evenly around. Join with sl st to first sc. 60 (68) sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Ch 1. Miss next sc. *1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Ch 1. Miss next sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Drawstring: Make a chain 60 ins [152 cm] long. Weave through ch-1 sps of last rnd meeting at center front. Tie ends in a bow.

Bag

Front and Back (make alike)

Ch 24.

Foundation row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. 23 sc.

1st row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 2 sc. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 30 sc.

3rd row: As 1st row.

4th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 3 sc. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 39 sc.

Work even in sc until work from beg measures 8 ins [20.5 cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

Place first set of markers on sides 7 ins [18 cm] up from foundation ch.

Next row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 3 sc. *Draw up a loop in each of next 2 sc. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook – Sc2tog made. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 30 sts.

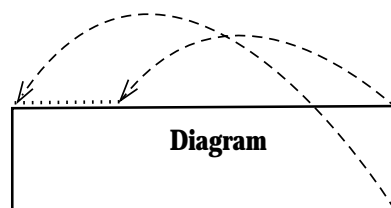
Next 3 rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

Place second set of markers at each end of last row.

Next 3 rows: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each st to end of row. Turn.

Next row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each dc to end of row. Fasten off.

Finishing: With **WS** of Front and Back tog, sew side and bottom seams between first set of markers. Fold top of bag through handles and sew upper edge to inside of bag between second set of markers.
