PRETTY CROCHET BAG

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 6 ins [15 cm] in diameter x 8 ins [20.5 cm] tall.

MATERIALS

Patons Brilliant (50 g/1.75 oz)
2 balls of 03320 (Prettiest Plum)
or 03416 (Perfect Pastels).

Size 3.75 mm (U.S. F or 5) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain tension**. Circle of cardboard or plastic canvas 6 ins [15 cm] in diameter. ¼ yd [0.3 m] of lining fabric.

TENSION

17 sc and 20 rows = 4 ins [10 cm].

Motif = Approx 6 ins [15 cm] along each side.

INSTRUCTIONS

Motif: Ch 5. Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

1st rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in ring. (Ch 5. 2 dc. Ch 3. 2 dc) twice in ring. (Ch 5. 2 dc. Ch 3) in ring. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.

2nd rnd: Sl st in next dc and ch-5 sp. Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in same ch-5 sp. Ch 4. [(Yoh) twice and draw up a loop in same ch-5 sp. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice] 3 times. Yoh and draw through all 4 loops on hook – Cluster made. Ch 5. Sl st in 5th ch from hook – Picot made. Ch 4. 2 dc in same ch-5 sp. [Ch 3. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3. (2 dc. Ch 4. Cluster. Picot. Ch 4. 2 dc) in next ch-5 sp] twice. Ch 3. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. 1 hdc in top of ch 3.

3rd rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc around post of last hdc. Ch 4. 1 sc in next ch-4 sp. (4 dc. Ch 3. 4 dc) in next picot. 1 sc in next ch-4 sp. Ch 4. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. [Ch 3. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 4. 1 sc in next ch-4 sp. (4 dc. Ch 3. 4 dc) in next picot. 1 sc in next ch-4 sp. Ch 4. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp] twice. Ch 1. 1 hdc in first sc.

4th rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc around post of last hdc. *1 dc in next sc. 4 dc in next ch-4 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. (2 dc. Ch 3. 2 dc) in next ch-3 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. 4 dc in next ch-4 sp. 1 dc in next sc. **3 dc in next ch-3 sp.* Rep from * to * once, then from * to **. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Join with sl st in top of ch 3.

5th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sl st. Ch 3. (Miss next 2 dc. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 3) 4 times. 1 sc in next corner ch-3 sp. Ch 5. Sl st in 1st ch of ch 5 – Corner picot made. Ch 3. 1 sc in next dc. [(Ch 3. Miss next 2 dc. 1 sc in next dc) 8 times. Ch 3. 1 sc in next corner ch-3 sp. Corner picot. Ch 3. 1 sc in next dc] twice. Ch 3. (Miss next 2 dc. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 3) 3 times. Join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Joining 2nd Motif: Work 1st to 4th rnds as given for Motif.

5th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sl st. (Ch 3. Miss next 2 dc. 1 sc in next dc) 4 times. Ch 3. 1 sc in corner ch-3 sp. Ch 2. Sl st in Corner picot of adjoining Motif. Ch 2. Sl st in 1st ch – Joining picot made. Ch 1. Sl st in next ch-3 sp of adjoining Motif. Ch 1. 1 sc in next dc. (Ch 1. Sl st in next ch-3 sp of adjoining Motif. Ch 1. Miss next 2 dc. 1 sc in next dc) 8 times. Ch 1. Sl st in next ch-3 sp of adjoining Motif. Ch 1. 1 sc in corner ch-3 sp. Joining picot. Ch 3. 1 sc in next dc. (Ch 3. Miss next 2 dc. 1 sc in next dc) 8 times. Ch 3. 1 sc in next corner ch-3 sp. Corner picot. Ch 3. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 3. (Miss next 2 dc. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 3) 3 times. Join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Joining First and Last Motifs: Work 1st to 4th rnds as given for Motif.

5th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sl st. (Ch 3. Miss next 2 dc. 1 sc in next dc) 4 times. Ch 3. 1 sc in corner ch-3 sp. [Joining picot. Ch 1. Sl st in next ch-3 sp of adjoining Motif. Ch 1. 1 sc in next dc. (Ch 1. Sl st in next ch-3 sp of adjoining Motif. Ch 1. Miss next 2 dc. 1 sc in next dc) 8 times. Ch 1. Sl st in next ch-3 sp of adjoining Motif. Ch 1. 1 sc in corner ch-3 sp] twice. Joining picot. Ch 3. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 3. (Miss next 2 dc. 1 sc in next dc. Ch 3) 3 times. Join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

BAG

Body of Bag: Make 6 Motifs, joining sides as shown in Diagram to form a ring.

Top edging: 1st rnd: Join yarn with sl st to any Corner picot. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. [(Ch 1. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 2. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp) 5 times. 1 sc in next Corner picot] twice. (Ch 1. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 2. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp) 5 times. Join with sl st to first sc. 78 sts.

2nd rnd: Ch 2 (counts as hdc). [(1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. 1 hdc in next sc. 2 hdc in next ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in next sc) 5 times. 1 hdc in next sc] twice. (1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. 1 hdc in next sc. 2 hdc in next ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in next sc) 5 times. Join with sl st in top of ch 2.

3rd rnd: Ch 2 (counts as hdc). 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st in top of ch 2.

Rep last rnd 3 times more.

Next rnd: (Eyelet rnd). Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in next hdc. Ch 1. Miss next hdc. *1 dc in each of next 2 hdc. Ch 1. Miss next hdc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in top of ch 3.

Next rnd: Ch 2 (counts as hdc). 1 hdc in next dc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. *1 hdc in each of next 2 dc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in top of ch 2.

Next rnd: Ch 2 (counts as hdc). 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st in top of ch 2.

Rep last rnd 3 times more.

Next rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sl st. *Ch 4. Miss next 2 hdc. 1 sc in next hdc. Rep from * to last 2 hdc. Ch 4. Miss next 2 hdc. Join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Base: Ch 3. Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 6 sc in ring. Join with sl st to first sc. 6 sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as last sl st. 2 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st in first sc. 12 sc.

3rd rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 18 sc.

4th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 24 sc.

5th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 30 sc.

6th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 4 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 36 sc.

7th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 5 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 42 sc.

8th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 6 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 48 sc.

9th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 7 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 54 sc.

10th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 8 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 60 sc.

11th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 9 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 66 sc.

12th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 10 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 72 sc.

13th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

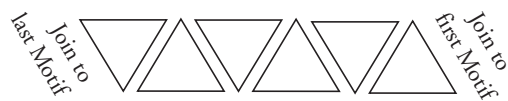
FINISHING

Pin Base to Body of Bag. Sew Base to bottom edge of Body of Bag, working into 4th rnd of Motifs behind 5th rnd and leaving ch-3 loops of 5th rnd free.

Place cardboard or plastic canvas in bottom of Bag to support Base.

Lining: Cut lining fabric 19 ins [48 cm] long by 8 ins [20.5 cm] wide. Press ½ inch [1.5 cm] to WS on each long edge for hem and sew in position. Sew short ends tog using French seam. Sew lining to inside Bag, having lower edge even with Base and upper edge below eyelet row.

Twisted cord: Cut 4 strands of yarn 60 ins [152.5 cm] long. With both strands tog, hold one end, and with someone holding other end, twist strands to the right until they begin to curl. Fold the 2 ends tog and tie in a knot so they will not unravel. The strands will now twist themselves tog. Knot ends tog to secure. Thread cord through eyelet row of Bag.
