WINE BOTTLE COVERS (UNFELTED AND FELTED)

MEASUREMENTS

Wine Bottle Cover A (Unfelted)

Approx 13 x 3½ ins
[33 x 9 cm].

Wine Bottle Cover B (Felted)

Approx 13 x 3½ ins
[33 x 9 cm] after felting.

Wine Bottle Bag C (Felted)

Approx 10 x 3½ ins
[25.5 x 9 cm] after felting.

Wine Chevron Bottle Cover D (Felted)

Approx 16 x 3½ ins
[40.5 x 9 cm] after felting.

MATERIALS

Patons® Classic Wool
(100 g / 3.5 oz)

BAG A, B or C only

Main Color (MC)

00230 (Bright Red) **1 ball** each

Contrast A

00208 (Burgundy) **1 ball** each

Contrast B

00220 (Bottle Green) **1 ball** each

Contrast C

00204 (Old Gold) **1 ball** each

Contrast D

00238 (Paprika) **1 ball** each

Contrast E

00240 (Leaf Green) **1 ball** each

BAG D only

Main Color (MC)

00230 (Bright Red) **1 ball**

Contrast A

00208 (Burgundy) **1 ball**

Contrast C

00204 (Old Gold) **1 ball**

Contrast D

00238 (Paprika) **1 ball**

Set of four size 4.5 mm (U.S. 7)
and size 5 mm (U.S. 8) double-
pointed knitting needles **or size
needed to obtain tension.**

TENSION

20 sts and 26 rows = 4 ins [10 cm]
with smaller needles in stocking st.

19 sts and 25 rows = 4 ins [10 cm]
with larger needles in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

WINE BOTTLE COVER A (UNFELTED)

With smaller double-pointed needles
and B, cast on 56 sts. Divide sts
onto 3 needles. Join in rnd.

1st rnd: *K2. P2. Rep from *
around.

With MC, rep last rnd until work
from beg measures 3 ins [7.5 cm].

With A, knit 6 rnds.

**With B, knit 1 rnd.

With E, knit 6 rnds.

With C, knit 2 rnds.

With D, knit 6 rnds.

With B, knit 1 rnd.

With MC, knit 6 rnds.

With A, knit 2 rnds.

With C, knit 2 rnds.

With E, knit 1 rnd.

With B, knit 6 rnds.

With D, knit 1 rnd.

With MC, knit 2 rnds.

With A, knit 6 rnds.

With B, knit 1 rnd.

With E, knit 6 rnds.

With D, knit 2 rnds.

With C, knit 1 rnd.

With B, knit 4 rnds.

With MC, knit 2 rnds.**

Next rnd: (Fold rnd). With MC,
purl.

Shape bottom: 1st rnd: *K5.
K2tog. Rep from * around. 48 sts.

2nd and alt rnds: Knit.

3rd rnd: *K4. K2tog. Rep from
* around. 40 sts.

5th rnd: *K3. K2tog. Rep from * around. 32 sts.

7th rnd: *K2. K2tog. Rep from * around. 24 sts.

9th rnd: *K1. K2tog. Rep from * around. 16 sts. Break yarn, leaving a long end.

Thread end through rem sts. Draw up firmly to close bottom and fasten securely.

Twisted cord: Cut 8 strands of A 65 ins [165 cm] long. With all strands tog hold one end and with someone holding other end, twist strands to the right until they begin to curl. Fold both ends tog and tie in a knot so they will not unravel. The strands will now twist themselves tog. Adjust length if desired.

Starting at center front, thread twisted cord through last row of (K2. P2) ribbing. Tie in a bow at front of Cover.

WINE BOTTLE COVER B (FELTED)

With larger double-pointed needles and B, cast on 72 sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd.

1st rnd: *K2. P2. Rep from * around.

With A, rep last rnd until work from beg measures 3 ins [7.5 cm].

With MC, knit 2 rnds.

With A, knit 8 rnds.

With B, knit 2 rnds.

With E, knit 8 rnds.

With C, knit 4 rnds.

With D, knit 8 rnds.

With B, knit 2 rnds.

With MC, knit 8 rnds.

With A, knit 4 rnds.

With C, knit 4 rnds.

With E, knit 2 rnds.

With B, knit 8 rnds.

With D, knit 2 rnds.

With MC, knit 4 rnds.

With A, knit 8 rnds.

With B, knit 2 rnds.

With E, knit 8 rnds.

With D, knit 4 rnds.

With C, knit 2 rnds.

With B, knit 6 rnds.

With MC, knit 2 rnds.

With A, knit 6 rnds.

Next rnd: (Fold rnd). Purl, dec 2 sts evenly around. 70 sts.

Shape bottom: 1st rnd: *K8. K2tog. Rep from * around. 63 sts.

2nd and alt rnds: Knit.

3rd rnd: *K7. K2tog. Rep from * around. 56 sts.

5th rnd: *K6. K2tog. Rep from * around. 49 sts.

7th rnd: *K5. K2tog. Rep from * around. 42 sts.

9th rnd: *K4. K2tog. Rep from * around. 35 sts.

11th rnd: *K3. K2tog. Rep from * around. 28 sts.

13th rnd: *K2. K2tog. Rep from * around. 21 sts.

15th rnd: *K1. K2tog. Rep from * around. 14 sts. Break yarn, leaving a long end.

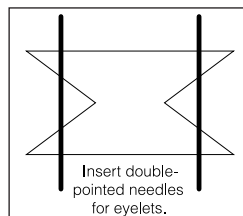
Thread end through rem sts and draw up firmly. Fasten securely.

FINISHING

Felt Bottle Cover following “How to Felt” Instructions. Shape Bottle Cover to measurements. If desired, place a 3½ ins [9 cm] circle of cardboard inside Bottle Cover to shape base while drying.

Eyelets: Before drying, fold top edge of cover as shown in diagram and poke end of double-pointed knitting needle through fabric for eyelets on each side 1½ ins [4 cm] below top edge. Leave needles in place while Cover dries. Dry away from heat and sunlight.

Twisted cord: Work as given for Wine Bottle Cover A (Knit Version).

WINE BOTTLE BAG C (FELTED)

With larger double-pointed needles and MC, cast on 72 sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd.

1st rnd: *K2. P2. Rep from * around.

Rep last rnd until work from beg measures 2 ins [5 cm].

With A, knit 6 rnds.

Rep from ** to ** as given for Wine Bottle Cover A.

With A, knit 4 rnds

Next rnd: (Fold rnd). With A, purl, dec 2 sts evenly around. 70 sts.

Shape bottom: Work as given for “Shape Bottom” Wine Bottle Cover B (Felted Version).

FINISHING

Felt Bag according to “How to Felt” instructions. Shape Bag to measurements. If desired, place a 3½ ins [9 cm] circle of cardboard inside Bag to shape base while drying.

Eyelets: Before drying, fold top edge of bag in half and poke end of double-pointed knitting needle through fabric for eyelets on each side 1½ ins [4 cm] below top edge and 1 inch [2.5 cm] from side edges. Leave needles in place while Bag dries. Dry away from heat and sunlight.

Twisted cord: (make 2). Cut 10 strands of A 60 ins [152.5 cm] long. With all strands tog hold one end and with someone holding other end, twist strands to the right until they begin to curl. Fold both ends tog and tie in a knot so they will not unravel. The strands will now twist themselves tog. Adjust length if desired.

Thread cord through eyelets to create a handle. Secure with knots at RS of Bag.

Rep for second handle.

CHEVRON WINE BOTTLE COVER D (FELTED)

Chevron Pat (Multiple of 16 sts).

1st rnd: *K6. Sl1. K2tog. pssso. K6. (K1. yfwd. K1) in next st. Rep from * around.

2nd rnd: *K5. Sl1. K2tog. pssso. K6. (K1. yfwd. K1) in next st. K1. Rep from * around.

3rd rnd: *K4. Sl1. K2tog. pssso. K6. (K1. yfwd. K1) in next st. K2. Rep from * around.

4th rnd: *K3. Sl1. K2tog. pssso. K6. (K1. yfwd. K1) in next st. K3. Rep from * around.

5th rnd: *K2. Sl1. K2tog. pssso. K6. (K1. yfwd. K1) in next st. K4. Rep from * around.

6th rnd: *K1. Sl1. K2tog. pssso. K6. (K1. yfwd. K1) in next st. K5. Rep from * around.

7th rnd: *Sl1. K2tog. pssso. K6. (K1. yfwd. K1) in next st. K6. Rep from * around.

These 1st to 7th rnds form Chevron Pat.

With larger double-pointed needles and A, cast on 96 sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd.

1st rnd: *K2. P2. Rep from * around. Rep last rnd until work from beg measures 3 ins [7.5 cm].

Proceed in Chevron Pat as follows:

With MC, work 7 rnds.

With D, work 2 rnds.

With A, work 8 rnds.

With C, work 4 rnds.

With MC, work 8 rnds.

With D, work 2 rnds.

With A, work 8 rnds.

With MC, work 4 rnds.

With C, work 4 rnds.

With A, work 2 rnds.

With D, work 8 rnds.

With MC, work 2 rnds.

With A, work 4 rnds.

With MC, work 8 rnds.

With D, work 2 rnds.

With A, work 2 rnds.

Next rnd: (Fold rnd). With A, purl, inc 2 sts evenly around. 98 sts.

Shape bottom: 1st rnd: *K12. K2tog. Rep from * around. 91 sts.

2nd rnd: *K11. K2tog. Rep from * around. 84 sts.

3rd rnd: *K10. K2tog. Rep from * around. 77 sts.

4th rnd: *K9. K2tog. Rep from * around. 70 sts.

5th rnd: *K8. K2tog. Rep from * around. 63 sts.

6th rnd: *K7. K2tog. Rep from * around. 56 sts.

7th rnd: *K6. K2tog. Rep from * around. 49 sts.

8th rnd: *K5. K2tog. Rep from * around. 42 sts.

9th rnd: *K4. K2tog. Rep from * around. 35 sts.

10th rnd: *K3. K2tog. Rep from * around. 28 sts.

11th rnd: *K2. K2tog. Rep from * around. 21 sts.

12th rnd: *K1. K2tog. Rep from * around. 14 sts. Break yarn, leaving a long end.

Thread end through rem sts. Tighten up and fasten securely.

FINISHING

Felt Cover following “How to Felt” Instructions. Shape Cover to measurements. If desired, place a 3½ ins [9 cm] circle of cardboard inside Cover to shape base while drying.

Twisted cord: Cut 10 strands of D 60 ins [152.5 cm] long. With all strands tog hold one end and with someone holding other end, twist strands to the right until they begin to curl. Fold both ends tog and tie in a knot so they will not unravel. The strands will now twist themselves tog. Adjust length if desired.

Tie cord around cover 2 ins [5 cm] below top.

Important to know before felting

- Record all the measurements and changes before and after felting. You will be able to adjust the method to produce proper results.
- Always test a sample. Different colored yarns may felt differently.
- Colorfastness can be affected by very hot water.

How To Felt

- Using low water level, run a Hot/Cold cycle for 5 to 15 min. Add a pair of old jeans for agitation.
- Add 2 tablespoons of baking soda for a small load. After one cycle, check for size. Repeat if necessary.
- Run through the rinse and dry spin cycle.
- Do not use a clothes dryer.
- Shape piece to correct measurements.
- Lay felted piece onto a dry towel, away from direct heat or sunlight.
- If an edge ripples, baste a thread through the edge and gather in. Remove the thread after the felting is dry.

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
